



IMPORTANT information about your appointment

Your doctor/dentist has requested you are seen by a specialist or have a test within the next **two weeks**.

You will be offered an appointment by telephone at the earliest opportunity.

It is **important** you make yourself available and attend this appointment.

Should I be worried?

The need for an early appointment does not mean you have cancer, however your doctor/dentist would like you to be seen by a specialist as soon as possible.

What is the Two Week Fast Track Scheme?

It's a national scheme to ensure anyone with symptoms/initial test results that may be suspicious of cancer will be seen by a specialist or have a specialist test within two weeks.

The aim is to exclude cancer or provide diagnosis, intervention and treatment, if required, at the earliest opportunity.

What happens now?

- You will receive an appointment by telephone. It is important to make yourself available for this in the next two weeks.
- You are welcome to bring a family member or friend with you.
